### DIVISIONS -----

( Div. & Cat. Must be entered correctly into LSAG Database when Registering If you need assistance with your division or category contact Teri Clark . )

#### **1. Division I : Accomplished** ( formerly Professional )

These artists are considered accomplished in their field. They are typically the leaders; teachers or judges, they understand the theories and principals of art and consistently win awards.

#### **2. Division II : Established** (formerly Semi-Professional)

These artists have a well-established history of their work, actively promote their art, and have a proven track record. They possess the technical skills necessary to teach others and routinely achieve artistic success.

#### **3. Division III : Emerging** (formerly Non-Professional)

These artists are typically early in their journey (3-7 years) but are more confident in their ability than in their Novice years. They are in the process of self-discovery and developing their artistic style.

#### **4. Division IV: Novice** (formerly Adult Student)

One who has created art for less than three years through self-study or under the direction of a teacher. After two (2) years of College Art (4 art courses) or three (3) years as a Novice, any LSAG member should automatically be placed in the Emerging Division.

#### **5. Division V : Youth** (formerly Student) **V-ES** ( K-5) **V-MS** ( 6-8 ) **VHS** ( 9-12 )

These young artists are school aged (pre-K-12). They are typically enrolled in public, private or home school, taking private lessons or are self-taught. This Division is divided as follows:

- a. Elementary (grades preK-5); b. Middle School (grades 6-8); c. High School (grades 9-12).

### LSAG ART SHOW ENTRIES RULES & REGULATIONS - ( PRESENTATION OF ARTWORK)

- Artwork must be your original work and must have been completed within the last two years.
- Each piece of artwork must have a TITLE - Untitled And "Un-Named" are not acceptable.
- Entries to be hung must be suitably framed and wired for hanging. Gallery wrapped canvases must be staple- free on the front and sides and minimally one and one-half inches deep.
- Wet paintings will not be accepted and Will Be Disqualified.

- ALL FRAMED ARTWORK and/or canvas needs to be properly wired with correct wire/hardware for hanging.
- **NO SAW TOOTH HANGERS** If frame comes with a Sawtooth Hanger please cover with tape to protect the Leagues fabric Art panels from being damaged.
- All Artwork that exceeds 32 inches wide requires the Artist to provide an Easel. ( Art Panels are “36” wide )
- 3D Art will be displayed on tables or can be placed on available pedestals. Or may bring own pedestal .
- ART MUST BE APPROPRIATE FOR FAMILY FRIENDLY EVENTS : The Tomball Art League retains the right to refuse acceptance of any work deemed NOT suitable or qualified for display or public viewing per LSAG and by a majority vote of the Tomball Art League present when receiving the work for the show. No nudes, gory violence and/or obscene words, figures or objects may be depicted in the art piece or Title of the Entry.
- Please be certain of the art Entry Size ; Dimensions are correctly listed in inches with the width ( **W** ) Width ( **H** ) Height ( **D** ) Depth. Depth represents 3-D work. Please use the OVERALL FRAMED SIZED (Do not use artwork unframed size) Reasoning: An art piece listed as 12” x 36” fits on display panels very different from a 36” x 12” piece. WxHxD matters.
- After your entry has been received, the online art registration information CANNOT be revised or changed. This Includes the Title, Entry Size, Division, and Category Placement . And NO substitution of artwork can be made.
- Free-standing works and/or sculptures are to be put in place or placed on the display /pedestal by the artist .
- Entrants of Artwork pieces wider than 36” will need to provide their own easel. Please check with Show chairman.
- No 3-D artwork is to be heavier than 25 lbs. and sculptural pieces must have a sturdy base.
- Small, delicate, and fragile 3-D art (earrings, paper sculpture, etc.) must be encased or framed and ready to hang or place on a flat tabletop or pedestal surface. Exhibiting artwork wider than 36 inches and/or heavier than 3 lbs., requires special consideration.
- ALL ART MUST BE COMPLETELY DRY and ready to hang or display when submitted on the day of intake for show.
- NO AI ASSISTANCE. The artist may NOT explicitly instruct the software’s generative AI to create any portion of their art.
- All Artwork will be Signed In and Signed Out. Art CANNOT be removed **BEFORE 3:30PM** NO EXCEPTIONS!

**B/W I.D. TAGS :** Before artwork is brought to show for showing Please FILL out 1 I.D. TAG for each piece of art. Attach to the back or attach to bottom if 3D. The ID Tags can be found on TAL website with other Show Forms. Needed for identification of your art.

**ARTWORK COLOR LABELS :** Please check your labels . Correct name, Art Name, Division & Category. Artwork Labels will be given to you at the intake table, after you have paid at the intake desk for your entry’s.

**NEW !  CLEAR POCKETS** – for Artwork Labels will be provided for with and for your Art Labels and will be attached to the Art Panel Next to your Art once it is hung or placed on a pedestal ready for judging. League Volunteers will be present to assist you. ( Help them match your art with your tags to ensure right tag gets with correct artwork.) *You no longer must figure out how to attach the labels to the front of your artwork!*
